

NOTICE TO HAMPTON CITIZENS

The Hampton Redevelopment and Housing Authority (HRHA) will hold a public hearing to discuss the proposed Allocation Plan to designate one (1) floor of a mixed population building to Elderly-only, as authorized by Section 7 of the U.S. Housing Act of 1937 (42 U.S.C. 1437e) as amended; and in compliance with 24 CFR 945.203(c). These developments currently house a mix of family types, including elderly, near-elderly, and young disabled.
